MISSION SHAKTI AWARENESS PROGRAM

In the last financial period, Shramik Seva Sansthan has trained 2250 women trained in 3 districts in Uttar Pradesh, under the Mission Shakti scheme, in this scheme in mission mode aimed at strengthening interventions for women safety, security and empowerment. It seeks to realise the Government's commitment for women-led development by addressing issues affecting women on a life-cycle continuum basis and by making them equal partners in nation-building through convergence and citizen-ownership.

The objective of the Mission Shakti is to provide to all women and girls including differently-abled, socially and economically marginalized and vulnerable groups, in need of care and protection, with short term and long-term services and information for their holistic development and empowerment.

AUTOMOTIVE SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

In the last financial period, Shramik Seva Sansthan has trained 100 daily wager employees working in unorganized institutions, under this PROGRAM to cope up with such a transformation, constant skilling, re-skilling and up-skilling of the existing and future workforce is extremely important. The new jobs, however, are likely to move away from traditional manufacturing and instead be added in the areas of IoT, mechatronics, robotics, 3D printing, AI, machine and deep learning, analytics, virtual collaboration, automotive design, and computational thinking.

Currently, there is a mismatch in certain areas between the skills that the industry requires and those possessed by the youth in our country. Hence, the Indian automotive sector may face a huge void if the structured reforms and initiatives are not taken to bridge the demand supply mismatch for the skilled workforce.









RURAL AGRICULTURE DEVLOPMENTPROGRAM

In the last financial period, Shramik Seva Sansthan allocated an important portion of its money to The Rural Agri Development Program. This program was intended to help rural communities become more self-sufficient through providing education resources, support, and training to improve their farming practices.

In the context of the Rural Development Program of the society, farmers from two villages of the District Block were educated about the fundamentals of scientific farming. Seeds with higher quality were given away at no cost to the villager. They were also taught how to make vermicomposting.





Additionally, farmers were introduced to the benefits from biodynamic manures. In addition, they were instilled to adopt the methods that are organic in their agricultural practices. Participants of this program gained a variety of advantages and encouraged others adhere to the same practices of organic farming.

The cost included the purchase of premium seeds, fertilizers, as well as modern farm equipment. In addition, we held workshops and seminars to help educate farmers about sustainable farming practices as well as crop rotation and organic farming practices.

WATER CONSERVATION, SANITATION & HYGIENE AWARENESS PROGRAM

Shramik Seva Sansthan was aware of the importance of conserving water sanitation, hygiene, and water conservation in enhancing the overall wellbeing of communities. To solve this problem, we made a commitment for various initiatives including the construction of water tanks, constructing water purification systems, as well as informing people about the importance of the proper practices for sanitation.

The primary goal that the group strives to attain is to supply fresh and pure water to members in the organization. Therefore, the tubes as wells, the water wells and ponds were cleaned by the assistance of people who belong to the group. The society members are conscious of the quality of water they drink and the community is actively involved in bringing awareness about the importance of sanitation facilities in areas of the slums. Insufficient toilet facilities are a problem for a majority of urban dwellers.

The increasing population has exacerbated the situation. It is clear that the administration working in the public sector haven't had a chance to achieve their goals. It is crucial for a volunteer to act to assist the officials of the city provide sanitation services to a growing number of people.

We also held seminars and workshops to inform people about the importance of having clean water and proper waste management and the importance of personal hygiene.



CONSUMER WELFARE PROGRAM

Shramik Seva Sansthan dedicated resources to the Consumer Welfare Program, aimed at protecting the rights and the interests of consumers. We organized awareness campaigns to inform consumers on their rights and fair-trade practices and the necessity of making informed purchasing choices.

Consumer awareness events were planned to educate the public on the rights granted by the Consumer Protection Act 1986. They were inspirational and awe-inspiring to the audience. It's widely acknowledged that customers, despite being charged affordable prices, are not offered high-quality goods by the business.

The items are packed in gorgeous packaging. Their quality is poor. This is why consumers are constantly being cheated by both sellers and producers. This isn't atypical when it comes to services. The participants were made aware of the many remedies available to them through the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 and the Rules and the producers that fill appeals. They were also informed of the proper method and procedure to fill out appeals. They were also given names and numbers of various representatives for consumers they could reach out to should they require it.

The costs included arranging seminars, workshops and public forums that addressed consumer complaints and offer legal assistance when needed. We also worked on behalf of local officials to make sure the observance of the consumer laws as well as regulations.



DRUG DE-ADDICTION AWARENESS CAMP

In recognition of the harmful consequences of drug abuse on both communities and individuals Shramik Sansthan recognized the negative effects of substance abuse on communities and individuals. a Drug Addiction Awareness Camp. The costs for the program included scheduling counselling sessions and medical consults as well as rehabilitation services for people who are struggling with addiction issues.

We've held workshops to inform people on the negative effects of drinking and alcoholism. The society's volunteers went to villages to inform people about the negative effects of drinking and smoking tobacco, as well as smoking tobacco. Through banners and posters, they were able

The costs include venue rentals and transportation costs, as well as materials along with facilitator's fee. We are pleased to announce the fact that we have helped an extensive number of women living in our community, empowering them with information and resources to fight for their rights and build more equal society.



POLIO AWARENESS PROGRAM

In the spirit of public health and safety, the Shramik Seva Sansthan has devoted resources to awareness of polio in the pulse. We have run massive awareness campaigns to inform the public on the significance of polio vaccination as well as the possibility in free services to get vaccinated.



Our costs in this field include the printing of informational materials and awareness drives. We also organize awareness drives as well as collaborating with local healthcare providers. Thanks to our efforts, we've achieved a rise in the polio vaccination rate within our communities and help in the elimination of this deadly disease.

The cost includes the costs of organizing awareness activities and mobilizing healthcare professionals as well as delivering vaccination services. Shramik Seva Sansthan is continuing to remain determined to end the illness and ensure the future of polio-free children within our communities.

VETERINARY PROGRAM

In the last year, we've conducted various awareness initiatives for the community of handicapped people. These programs included creating workshops, skill development workshops, as well as awareness campaigns to encourage equal access and opportunities for those with disabilities.

We intend to create an institution that caters to handicapped students. Other initiatives include promoting awareness in the general public. Concerning disabled people, the society has ensured that they are not excluded from their communities. In addition, the society has held a contest for handicapped people to test their abilities in this specific field. The society intends to offer the works for sale. The society plans to build an educational facility for disabled persons.



The idea can be described as couples encouraged to believe in having one child for each couple. AIDS & CANCER AWARENESS PROGRAM

Shramik Seva Sanstha has devoted considerable resources to running AIDS as well as Cancer awareness events in the community. The initiatives include arranging workshops for education, distribution of informational materials, as well as conducting awareness campaigns to encourage early detection, prevention, and assistance for people who are affected by AIDS or Cancer.

HIV is the current biggest threat to humanity. Since it is a disease that spreads, the risk it poses to people is immense. The most efficient ways to avoid AIDS is by being conscious of many ways AIDS could manifest. We organized a camp to help people understand the procedure of receiving blood injections treatments, as well as other blood-related products. Experts also used an overall approach to make sure that patients are protected from cancer. The cancer awareness campaign consisted of road shows and small gatherings inside villages.



The expenses associated with these programs include venue rentals, transportation, printing of informational materials, guest speaker fees, and counselling services. By raising awareness and providing support, we aim to reduce the stigma associated with AIDS and Cancer, encourage early detection, and improve the overall well-being of affected individuals and their families.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING AND EDUCATIONAL AWARENESS PROGRAM

In the past, Shramik Seva Sansthan has given a substantial portion of its budget for its Vocational Training and Educational Awareness Program. The program is designed to help people by empowering individuals with the essential abilities and skills to increase their abilities to find work. The costs incurred are the cost of training equipment as well as the hiring of qualified trainers as well as organizing seminars and workshops.



This program lets females and girls the chance to get training in a variety of areas like tailoring and knitting embroidery, ready-made clothing and ready-made items Food Processing, Fashion Designing, and much more. With highly experienced instructors. The principal goal of the course is to aid the students in developing the necessary abilities to be self-sufficient and be able to stand on their own themselves.

Furthermore, the funds were used to promote the program using various channels in order to bring the program to a wider public. The program has trained many people, allowing them to get better job opportunities and increase their income.

COMPUTER EDUCATION PROGRAM

Recognizing the importance of digital literacy in today's world, Shramik Seva Sansthan has invested in computer education initiatives. The expenses for this program involved setting up computer labs, purchasing computers and software, and hiring experienced instructors.





The organization also provided scholarships to underprivileged individuals to enable them to access computer education. MINI DIARY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM
